

ONE CONVERSATION

Parents: Begin by reading Matthew 28:16-20. This is probably a very familiar passage to you as it is the Great Commission. Examine your own heart and life and evaluate whether you are being obedient to God's Word in making disciples.

We were made to glorify God (Isa. 43:7) and we do that by making disciples of all nations (Matt. 20:19-20). Jesus is king and calls us to spread the good news of His kingdom by making disciples. Think about some ways you can serve and share the love of Christ with those in your neighborhood or community who might not know Him as their Lord and Savior.

Be open and willing to go wherever God might send you as you seek to live out the Great Commission in your life.
